Peter Metz's impact on the Port Washington High School soccer program was immediate and profound. As a varsity freshman player, he set the tone by modeling what it meant to be a dedicated, team-first athlete striving for excellence. His leadership by example quickly earned the respect of teammates and coaches alike, culminating in being named team MVP in his very first season. Over his four-year varsity career, Peter consistently raised the standard for PWHS soccer. He helped lead the team to three consecutive winning seasons—a rare feat at the time—guiding them to top-10 state rankings while competing in one of Wisconsin's toughest soccer conferences. Under his leadership, the team won three regional championships and reached two sectional finals. He was named team MVP all four years and served as captain his senior year. Peter's talent and sportsmanship were recognized far beyond Port Washington. He was named Second Team All-Conference as a sophomore and First Team All-Conference and First Team All-State in both his junior and senior years. In his final season, he earned Conference Player of the Year honors by unanimous vote and was runner-up for the prestigious Gatorade State Player of the Year award. He graduated as the school's all-time leader in career goals and single-season goals, and ranked second in career assists. His stellar high school career earned him a full Division I scholarship to UW-Milwaukee, where he became a four-year starter and team captain as a senior. Peter was selected for multiple all-tournament teams during his collegiate career.

Peter's love for the game never faded. For over 30 years, he has devoted himself to coaching and mentoring young players, helping them develop the same leadership, character, and skills that defined his own career. As the Director of Coaching for the Germantown Soccer Club, he has positively influenced the lives of countless individuals. If you ask him about his career, he would say that his ongoing work to coach others is his proudest accomplishment. In a program often outsized by its opponents, Peter Metz emerged as a defining leader—setting a standard of excellence and humility that shaped the team's identity for years to come. Even now, when reflecting on his time at PWHS, he speaks not of personal records, but of teammates and shared moments. His legacy is not only written in the record books, but in the culture he helped create—a true Hall of Famer in every sense.
