ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Dear Parent/Guardian:

If your student is to be considered eligible to compete in interscholastic sports at Thomas Jefferson Middle School, the following items must be on file, for the current school year, in the school office before they will be allowed to practice or participate:

A *Physical Examination Form signed by the doctor

NOTE: Current physical fitness to participate in sports:

- Physical examination taken April 1 and after is valid for the following two school years
- Physical examination taken before April 1 is valid only for remainder of that school year and following school year
- In the year when an examination is not required, an Alternate Year Athletic Permit Card must be signed by a parent or guardian and be on file

Interscholastic Sports Activity Fee

The fee is \$60.00, which covers all Interscholastic Sports for the current year. (Family Max is \$120.00)

Concussion Awareness– complete during online registration or pick up form in office or print off our website

Interscholastic sports require a signed agreement form. Concussion Awareness information and form is available from the coaches, on our website, and in the TJMS Office. Once the form is signed by the parent and student the form is then returned directly to the coach.
